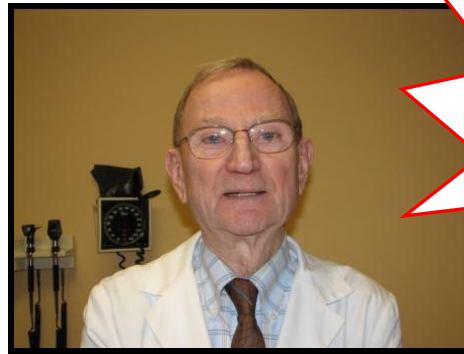


Volunteer Star
